

Scholarship Requirements

Statement Of Eligibility

- The applicant must be the child of an employee who has been declared to be permanently and totally disabled or who was fatally injured as a result of a work-related injury or occupational disease.
- The death or injury or illness must have occurred as a result of work activities performed for an Ohio employer covered by the Ohio workers' compensation law.
- The injury or death must have resulted in a decline in the family's income.
- The applicant must be between the ages of 16 and 25.
- The applicant must be enrolled time in a trade or vocational school; in industrial/commercial training; at a junior college or community college; in an undergraduate program at a college or university; or in a graduate program at a university.

Scholarship Application Guidelines

- Applicants must submit a scholarship application form with all supporting documents.
- Applications must be submitted no later than one month before the beginning of the semester or quarter.

- Scholarships are awarded on the basis of a student's need and the funds available to Kids' Chance of Ohio. The maximum scholarship award is \$5000 per year.
- Scholarships may be used to pay tuition/fees, books, and room and board.
